Reclaiming Equipment at the Port of Bristol

Strachan & Henshaw Limited, Bristol, UK, have completed the installation and commissioning of the three coal stockyard machines at the Royal Portbury Dock in the Port of Bristol. Strachan & Henshaw is a WEIR Group company.

The development of the Coal Import Terminal is a Joint Venture between the Port of Bristol and National Power, and the main contractor for the turnkey project is the Balfour Beatty/Birtley Engineering Joint Venture. Strachan & Henshaw were awarded the contract for the three stock yard machines in November 1991. The terminal is rated to handle up to 7 million t/a of coal and other commodities and includes two continuous ship unloaders, extensive conveyor systems and wagon loading plant in addition to the stockyard equipment.
