New Academic Grant Program from Micromeritics

Micromeritics introduced a new initiative to maximize the value of university research funding through the Micromeritics Academic Grant Program. This program seeks to accelerate academic research by increasing access to state-of-the-art materials characterization technology. Today, Micromeritics systems are used in more than 90% of the world's top universities to generate data that appears in over 200,000 peer-reviewed publications and 40,000 patents.

Eligible participants will receive matching grant funds or a lump-sum to apply toward the purchase of Micromeritics systems for characterization of surface area, porosity, density, powder flow, and catalyst activity.
