TAKRAF Italy wins Ship Loader Supply Contract for a Project in Chile.

Towards the end of October 2018, TAKRAF Italy won a significant contract for the supply of a ship loader for an important expansion project in Chile. This award follows the signing of an important contract with a large global diversified mining company and confirms TAKRAF Italy's growing reputation for the supply of marine equipment in the Americas.

The project concerns one of the world's largest undeveloped copper resources, with the ship loader being designed to load copper concentrate into ocean vessels ranging from 15,000 DWT up to 60,000 DWT. The equipment will be capable of luffing / slewing and will be equipped with a shuttle enabling a significant outreach. The design will be executed in strict accordance with the Chilean Seismic code.
